- \*\*\* We ask that personal valuables be kept with athletes, coaches, and chaperones. \*\*\***

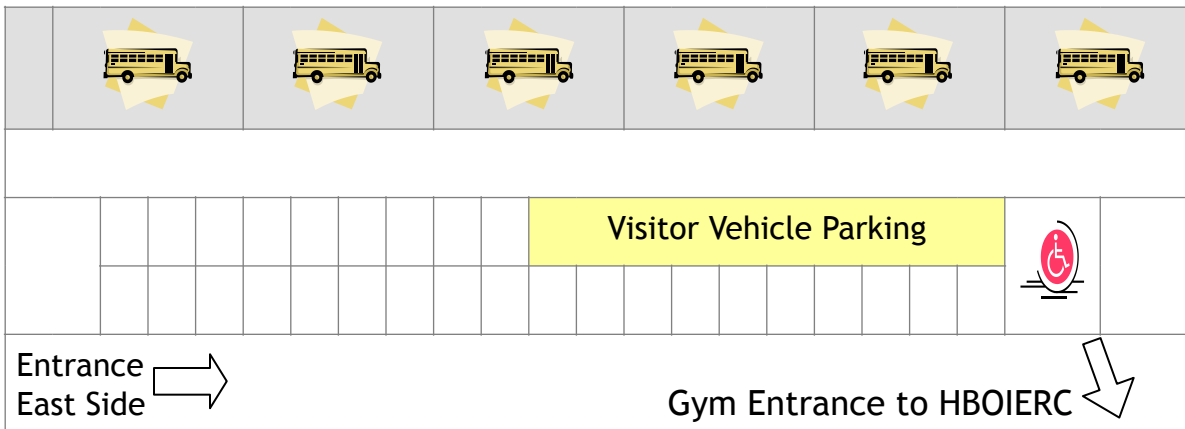

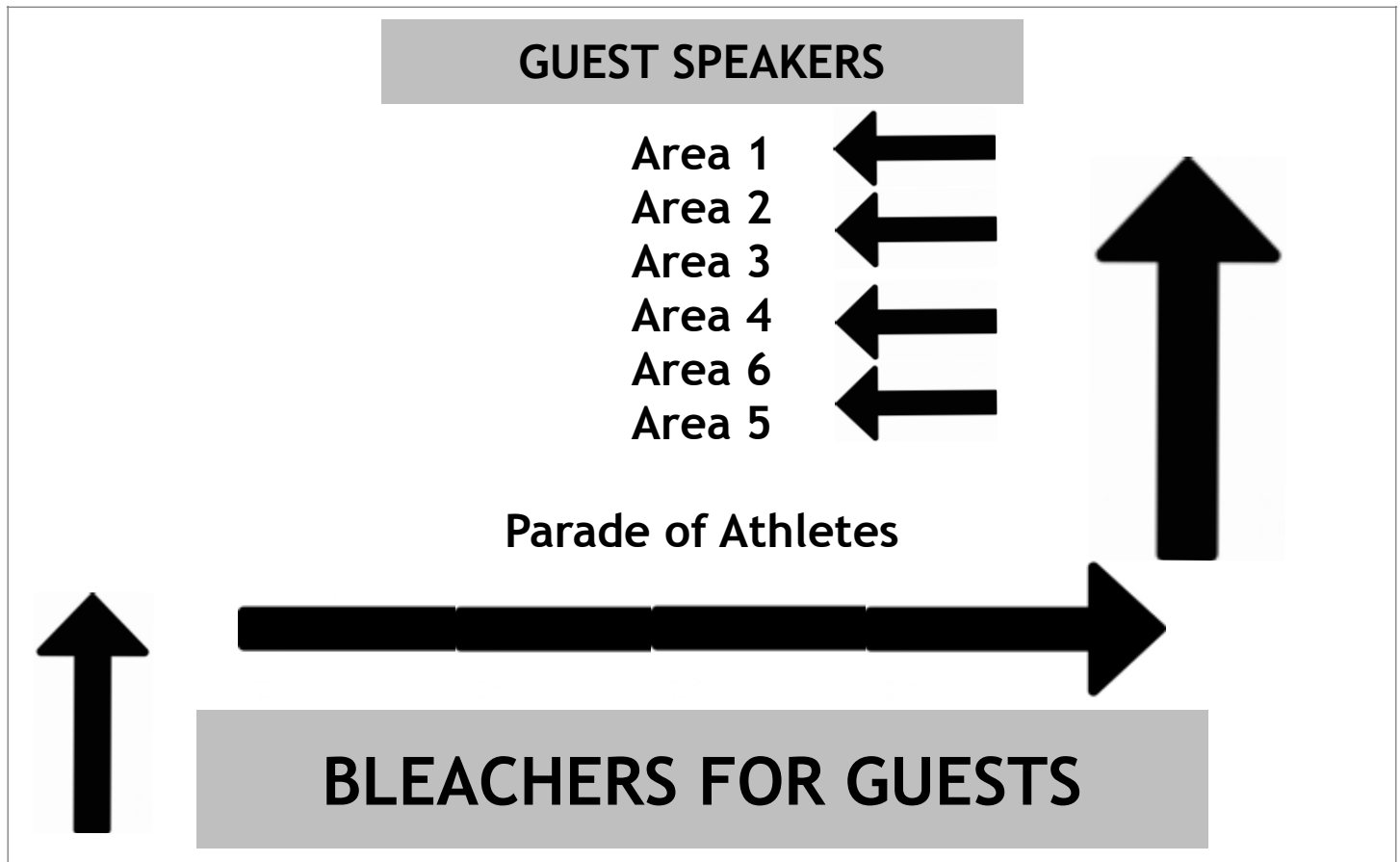


## Opening Ceremonies
